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His point about our anti-tax mindset, as a culture, is true as well.

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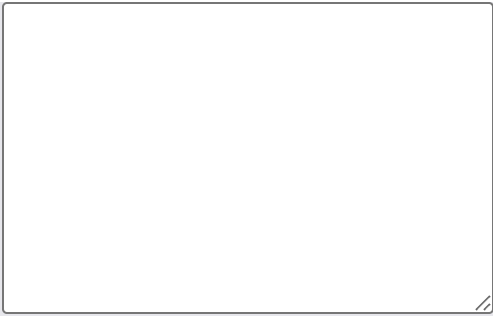
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
