The Georgia Board of Education hears a complaint tomorrow from Laura Mallory, a Loganville, GA, woman who says the Harry Potter book series "promotes and glorifies witchcraft". The board will hear oral arguments in the case and is then scheduled to rule on the case at its December meeting. The Gwinnett county school board ruled in favor of the books in May.
